NMVTIS to Texas Conversion Chart

NMVTIS CODES / BRANDS	TEXAS BRAND / PROCEDURES
01 Flood Damage	Flood Damage
02 Fire Damage	This is a salvage vehicle. Applicant must complete the rebuilt vehicle process, pay the rebuilt fee, and the record should be branded as "Rebuilt Salvage." Otherwise the applicant must apply for a Salvage or Nonrepairable Vehicle Title with the department.
04 Salt Water Damage	Flood Damage
07 Dismantled	The applicant must apply for a Nonrepairable Vehicle Title or Certificate of Authority (COA).
08 Junk	The applicant must apply for a Nonrepairable Vehicle Title or Certificate of Authority (COA).
09 Rebuilt	Rebuilt Salvage
10 Reconstructed	Reconstructed
11 Salvage - Damage or Not Specified	This is a salvage vehicle. Applicant must complete the rebuilt vehicle process, pay the rebuilt fee, and the record should be branded as "Rebuilt Salvage." Otherwise the applicant must apply for a Salvage or Nonrepairable Vehicle Title with the department.
16 Salvage Retention	This is a salvage vehicle. Applicant must complete the rebuilt vehicle process, pay the rebuilt fee, and the record should be branded as "Rebuilt Salvage." Otherwise the applicant must apply for a Salvage or Nonrepairable Vehicle Title with the department.
23 Warranty Return	Manufacturer Buyback
28 Street Rod	Send to the TxDMV in a NMVTIS Specially Marked Envelope.
30 Replica	Replica
31 Totaled	This is a salvage vehicle. Applicant must complete the rebuilt vehicle process, pay the rebuilt fee, and the record should be branded as "Rebuilt Salvage." Otherwise the applicant must apply for a Salvage or Nonrepairable Vehicle Title with the department.
32 Owner Retained	This is a salvage vehicle. Applicant must complete the rebuilt vehicle process, pay the rebuilt fee, and the record should be branded as "Rebuilt Salvage." Otherwise the applicant must apply for a Salvage or Nonrepairable Vehicle Title with the department.

43 VIN Replaced by a New State Assigned VIN	Send to the TxDMV in a NMVTIS Specially Marked Envelope.
45 Gray Market	Vehicle cannot be titled in Texas. Send to the TxDMV in a NMVTIS Specially Marked Envelope.
47 Manufacturer Buy Back	Manufacturer Buyback
50 Salvage – Reasons Other than Damage or Stolen	This is a salvage vehicle. Applicant must complete the rebuilt vehicle process, pay the rebuilt fee, and the record should be branded as "Rebuilt Salvage." Otherwise the applicant must apply for a Salvage or Nonrepairable Vehicle Title with the department.
52 Prior Non-Repairable / Repaired	Rebuilt Salvage
53 Crushed	The applicant must apply for a Nonrepairable Vehicle Title or Certificate of Authority (COA).
56 Export Only Vehicle	Vehicle cannot be titled in Texas. Send to the TxDMV in a NMVTIS Specially Marked Envelope.
68 Actual	Actual Mileage
69 Not Actual	Not Actual Mileage
70 Not Actual – Odometer Tampering Verified	Not Actual Mileage
71 Exempt from Odometer Disclosure	Exempt
72 Exceeds Mechanical Limits	Mileage Exceeds Mechanical Limits
73 Odometer May Be Altered	Not Actual Mileage
74 Odometer Replaced	Not Actual Mileage
